## Liquor Liability and You

1. The server of alcoholic beverages may be liable for injuries sustained by intoxicated persons.
2. The host of a gathering may also be held liable for injuries caused by intoxicated persons.

To prevent unnecessary pain and/or injury of an accident the Town suggests the following:

- Have available and promote the consumption of non-alcoholic beverages.
- If possible, use a licensed bartender (operator) to dispense your drinks. The avoidance of serious injury due to experienced handling may be worth the cost of a licensed operator.
- Check each person's ID. You must be 21 years old to drink in Wisconsin.

If you suspect someone has had too much to drink:

1. STOP serving them!
2. Do Not let them drive.
3. If you cannot handle the situation, call 911.
